

# THE RALEIGH CEMETERY

Visited November 15, 1969. This cemetery is located on the west side of the Raleigh-LaGrange Road, about two blocks south of the town of Raleigh, Tennessee. It is one of the oldest cemeteries in Shelby County. During the early fall of 1969, a large portion of the grounds was cleared of major undergrowth, but parts of the cemetery were still overgrown, and examination was difficult. A few large slabs and stones have fallen or have been turned face-down and could not be raised for reading the inscriptions. A ravine has eroded one side of the cemetery, and many stones may have fallen into it. The undergrowth in parts of the cemetery may cover other stones, as many of the following inscriptions were obtained from stones dug from under their leaf and dirt cover. The cemetery contains a large number of sunken places that indicate many unmarked graves.
