EDMONDSON CEMETERY

Visited November 11, 1969 and January 4, 1970. This well kept cemetery is located on the north side of the State Line Road, between Millbranch Road and Interstate 55, about 0.2 mile south of the Tennessee State Line in DeSoto County, Mississippi. Early surveys placed the area in Tennessee. The cemetery was used as a burial place for families that lived between Nonconnah Creek on the north and Nesbit, Mississippi, on the south.

In 1837, William Edmiston purchased Sections 13 and 14 of Range 8, Township 1 West per the survey of the Chickasaw Nation, from Jno. H. Morgan (Shelby County Record Book F, p. 306.)

The first school in the area, established in 1843, was located on the nearby property of Daniel Hilderbrand. Its name was Pisgah, although it was sometimes called Edmiston School. The first Presbyterian church in the area was organized in the Pisgah schoolhouse in 1844. The old session book read:

"At a meeting of a number of individuals residing in Shelby County, Tennessee, and DeSoto County, Mississippi, at a schoolhouse in the county of Shelby known as the Edmiston School House, the 27th of April 1844 .... it was agreed by those present .... to be organized into a church, whereupon the names of Mrs. Kennedy, Mrs. John H. Morgan, Mrs. Lake, Mrs. H.N. Boon, Mrs. Sarah White, Mrs. Isaac Tipton were duly organized into a church. It was resolved that the church be known by the name of Pisgah."

For a time, services were held in the schoolhouse. In June 1847, "after mature deliberation and conferring with the members, it was determined to erect a house of worship." In September, William Edmiston sold two acres for twenty dollars and gave two more acres from his purchase of Section 13 to "C. Bias, John K. Nelson, A.R. Hutchison and William Edmiston, Commissioners for procuring ground and building a Presbyterian Church to be called Pisgah." (DeSoto County, Mississippi, Deed Book K, page \_\_.) At the same time, the plat of the cemetery was made. The site appears to have been used for burials for at least two years prior to the property deed.

In October 1847, the Session Book records that a House of Worship had been erected about one mile (west) of the schoolhouse, and the session agreed to change the name from Pisgah to Edmiston. The name was spelled as Edmiston until 1862, and then was written as Edmonson. After a second book was begun in 1866, the name was spelled Edmondson in recognition of services that family had given the church.

At least two other deeds refer to the school house and church. One refers to the "old school house" (Shelby County Record Book 7, page 498 (1851).) The other refers to a point "near Edmondson Church" (Shelby County Record Book 15, page 420 (1851).)

William Edmiston, grantor and donor of the land, is not believed to have been buried there. His daughter, Martha, wife of John Hall Morgan, and her family are buried there in Lot 40.

In 1929, the Edmondson Church and Cemetery Association was incorporated in the State of Mississippi, with the incorporators:

The map on the second preceding page shows the lot numbers and present arrangement of the cemetery. Until the Depression years of 1932-1934, the old church stood next to the cemetery, but the old building had had no services held in it for years and needed repairs, so it was sold. Lots with alphabet letters and numbers 1 through 99 represent the oldest portion of the cemetery. Lots 100 through 190 represent cemetery expansion to 1928. Lots 191 through 254 represent expansion to 1953, while Lots to No. 272 were added in 1953. The area of Lots 255 through 272 was the site of the now vanished church building. Because of the few remaining lots in the cemetery, grave space is now limited to the families already represented there.

During the early years of existence of the church and cemetery, records of many of the interments and of church affairs were kept by the late Emmett E. Elam, whose son, John Edward Elam, still has the original plat map of the cemetery. Later the records were kept by the late Mrs. Hector Bowe, and by the late Mr. and Mrs. Orren Taylor Pickard, and are presently kept by Miss Anna Leigh McCorkle, 4334 McCorkle Road.

A brick wall fronts the cemetery. A plaque beside the gate:

Edmondson Presbyterian Church  
With Cemetery  
Established 1844

The compilers of this volume are grateful to the Edmondson Cemetery Association for their generosity in sharing the old record books and maps of the cemetery, and for the hours its president, Miss Anna Leigh McCorkle, has used in checking and re-checking the following data to eliminate as many errors as possible. For several years, Miss McCorkle has made constant efforts to contact members of the families and to obtain any possible information about those buried there. Miss McCorkle is the author of Tales of Old Whitehaven, published 1967, which contains much information about many of the persons buried in Edmondson Cemetery. A list of lot owners follows. Names of the first lot owners are shown on the list for historical purposes. In many cases there were no burials for those families. Such lots have been transferred to the present day owners who sometimes were descendants of the old owners. These present owners are indicated below in parentheses.
