Visited May 14, 1970. This cemetery was located on property rented by Mr. and Mrs. Charles R. Bounds, 6900 East Holmes Road, just east of Ross Road. The cemetery was a good distance behind the house and east of the barn, situated on top of a hill amid cedar trees. Remains of an iron and wire fence were visible. There was space for many other graves, and other stones were said to have been there in past years.
