### INDEPENDENCE (SIGLER) CEMETERY

Visited January 25, 1970. Located on the east side of Ward Road at the intersection of Independence Road, about a mile south of Russell Bond Road, between Cuba and Millington, Tennessee. The cemetery has a large grove of old cedar trees and is in good condition.

The compilers found an unusual arrangement for marking some otherwise unmarked graves. The footstones of many of the graves have apparently been removed, in some cases two of those footstones have been cemented together and the resulting stone placed to mark a grave with the initialed part of the footstones in the ground. These were checked for initials and in the following data are shown with the headstone to which each appears to belong. Such footstones are marked with an asterik. Near one of the trees was a pile of loose footstones. These are also indicated below.
