## LOG UNION CEMETERY

Visited May 17, 1970. This cemetery is located on the west side of Seed Tick Road, 1.1 mile south of the Memphis-Arlington Road. It is northeast of Lakeland and between Ellendale and Arlington, Tennessee. The cemetery was enclosed by a wire fence and appeared to have been cleared the previous year, as the growth of vines and bushes was small.
