

POINT CHURCH CEMETERY

Visited January 25, 1970. Located across the street from the Georgian Hills Methodist Church, 3925 Overton Crossing Road, in the Frayser area of Memphis. Mr. Horace P. Colby, Jr., 1156 Chelsea, Memphis, advised the compilers that he was the son of the late Horace P. Colby and of Anna (Schoolfield) Colby, daughter of James Sheffey Schoolfield (See Schoolfield Cemetery); that his father owned 30 acres south of and adjoining the cemetery, and that there had been an Episcopal and then a Methodist Church on the site. Mr. Colby compiled a book on the Schoolfield family for the members of his family.
