

## JONES-BARTON FAMILY CEMETERY

Visited November 2, 1974. This small, well-kept family cemetery is located on the north side of the Hawkins Mill Road at the intersection with the New Allen Road. A nearby resident told compilers that family members cleaned the cemetery two or three times each summer. In addition to the stones with inscriptions shown below, there were two concrete tables and a concrete bench within the fenced area. The base of the pedestal of one of the tables had the following data roughly printed in the material: W.L.D. (and) 6-14-47.

## LAYTON FAMILY CEMETERY

Visited October 20, 1973. This small, somewhat overgrown cemetery, is located south of Highway #70/79 between the highway and Gallaway, Tennessee and east of Arlington, Tennessee. It is near the southwest corner of Layton Road and Senator Street, about 50 yards west of the Old Brownsville Road. It is near the Shelby-Fayette county line in Fayette County, Tennessee. The various spellings for the Gallaway family inscriptions shown below have been checked and are correct as shown.
