

ARLINGTON, TENNESSEE CEMETERY

Visited September 22 and October 13, 1973. This nicely maintained cemetery is located 1.1 miles south of Highway #70/79, on the Collierville-Arlington Road at Hayes Road. The Collierville-Arlington Road is called Chester Road as it passes through the town of Arlington. When the compilers first arrived at the cemetery, the grounds presented a checkerboard pattern of cut and uncut lots. Early in the afternoon a group of young people began arriving, and each had a power mower or some other lawn-carrying instrument. They began work all over the cemetery, and by the time the compilers left the grounds had been manicured. There is no caretaker for the cemetery, but many local families maintain their own lots. Unattended lots are then cut and kept by the neighborhood young people as a community project. Mr. James Wilson of Arlington has the plat map of the cemetery. In the inscriptions below, the compilers noted an unusually large proportion of stones showing only the years of birth and death.

Mr. Stanley Osborne told compilers he was a grandson of Mrs. C.M. Osborn (1863-1959) whose mother was a sister of General Robert E. Lee.

Mr. James N. Wilson, Arlington, TN, a son of the late Milton Spencer Wilson, told compilers his father was born April 24, 1900. Mr. Wilson has a plat of the cemetery, the land for which was given by Dr. John Pryor Douglas and Mrs. Horace Sidney Griffin. The compilers were told the first burial in the cemetery was that of Caroline Louise Pitman, wife of Dr. John Pryor Douglas, in 1909. Many of the monuments in the cemetery show death dates earlier than 1909, and represent graves moved into Arlington Cemetery from other places. Mr. Wilson said all lots in the cemetery are 20 x 20 feet, and are intended for eight graves. Plans are being made to form an association to provide perpetual care for the cemetery.

Mrs. Alexander Marion Cuninghame gave compilers the following information: Her name before her marriage was Margaret Elliott Griffin. She is the daughter of Horace Sidney Griffin and his second wife, Mrs. Jessie Minning Griffin who was the widow of his brother James Henry Griffin, Jr.

Horace Sidney Griffin was the oldest son of James Henry Griffin Sr. and his wife Zylphia Thomas. They settled near Arlington (then Haysville) on part of a land grant to her grandfather Ensign John Thomas of Iredell Co., NC, for his services in the Revolutionary War. James Henry and Zylphia Thomas Griffin are buried in the old Thomas Cemetery on the Harrell Road. Some of the Harrell family were removed from the Thomas Cemetery to the Arlington Cemetery. Dr. William Samuel McCormick married Ora Burrows. They had twin sons, Ralph N. McCormick who did not marry, and Rudolph B. McCormick who married Mildred Durr; and a daughter Sameva McCormick who did not marry.
