ROBERTS FAMILY CEMETERY

Visited October 13, 1973. This small cemetery, greatly overgrown had been discovered the previous week by county engineers who were preparing to widen Winchester Road. The county had purchased a width of 70 feet, about 35 feet on each side of two-lane Winchester, and the tombstones were discovered when bulldozers began leveling the width for grading for the new road. When the compilers arrived at the site, approximately 100 yards west of the gate of Wyndyke Country Club, east of Hack's Cross Road, the new roadbed was cleared in all directions except for one thicket about fifty feet in length along the north edge of Winchester. The two stones found were about twenty-five feet apart.
