

## GERMANTOWN CEMETERY ON MCVAY ROAD

Since this cemetery was copied (See Volume I, Pages 14-17) in 1969, a local civic group has had the dense undergrowth cleared. The compilers visited the area on March 8, 1975. One of the Roberts' stones found on Winchester Road (See Vol. III, p. 54) has been moved to this cemetery. The whereabouts of the other one is unknown. The clearing brought a few more stones to view:
