#### MAGNOLIA CEMETERY

Visited November 3, 1973. This cemetery is well kept on the whole, but some areas are slightly overgrown, and grass has been allowed to grow over monuments such as sinking cradle graves. Many loose footstones were found together in small piles by tree trunks and the concrete border around separate lots. It is located on the eastern edge of Collierville, Tennessee, 8/10 of a mile south of Highway #57 on Mount Pleasant Road at the intersection with Keough Road. The older portions of the currently used cemetery are clearly divided into lots, and the following inscriptions are presented by lots.

Magnolia was originally a Brown Family Cemetery. In May 1878 William J. Brown sold 57 1/2 acres surrounding the family cemetery to a group of Collierville stockholders. In 1912 the cemetery was resold to the owners of the lots. A stone wall was built in 1940 by the lot owners through subscription where you can read some of their names.

During the Civil War Battle of Collierville in 1862, a young boy was wounded and carried to the home of Mrs. Brown. He died and was buried in the Brown Cemetery and has become known as The Unknown Soldier.

A history of the cemetery and the list of Confederate Soldiers was loaned to the compilers on November 8, 1975 by Mrs. Howard Carrington, 231 College St., Collierville, TN. She is the daughter of Mrs. Franklin Kelsey. The Cemetery records are housed in the Collierville Funeral Home.
