The following information is from a conversation with Miss Ada Strong. Miss Strong was the daughter of Squire Edgar Earl Strong, and his wife, Myrtle Scott, who was the daughter of Fernando T. Scott (buried in the Germantown Cemetery on McVay Road (V. I, pp. 14-16), and his wife, Sallie Medora Roberts. Sallie was the daughter of J.S. Roberts, who was born in Virginia (per Death Certificate #474, Shelby County for Sallie M.R. Scott) and died 8/4/1930. Sallie M. Roberts was born near Forest Hill on Oct 5, 1851. Fernando T. Scott had brothers Richmond L. and J. Milton Scott. Note: There is a stone for Richmond L. but none found for J. Milton. Can loose footstone IMS be JMS? Stone for his wives Louise V. and Minerva are listed. Mary Kincannon (V.I, p. 15), mother of Sallie M. Roberts Scott, was the widow of Schuyler H. Roberts and she remarried when he died.
