

ROYSTER FAMILY BURIALS

Green Bottom Cumberland Presbyterian Church and Morning Sun Cumberland Presbyterian joined together in 1832 and bought four acres from the Davis family. Mr. Thurman, an elder, married a Royster who is buried in the church cemetery (now a Black Church), but the remains were moved to Morning Sun Cemetery. Names of some of the people in the graveyard showed their color as "white" on the census and there may be others. It is located near the road on Highway #64 at Tray Creek Road (now Airline).
