## PISGAH CEMETERY (V.I p.90) ADDITIONS

Nicholas Blackwell, whose family donated the land for the Bartlett school and it is named after him, is buried with his family on his old homestead, but his monument, along with others of the family, was moved to Pisqah at Ellendale without removal of the remains. His estate later joined that of James Blackwell.

There seems to be a confusion in reading a three-sided monument on the Bond family, therefore all items will be listed:

## ECHLES CEMETERY (See V. II, p. 317)

It is located on Carnes between Eckles (mispelled from family name) and Goodman. This cemetery holds the ancestors of Harry Madison of Eudora, MS. Mr. Madison moved to Eudora about 1967 but was born and raised in the neighborhood. Those known to be buried in this family graveyard are:

George Echles, who died in 1896.

Martha, wife of George Echles, died in 1887. She was from Sussex County Virginia.

Harry Madison Sr.

Roger Madison, son of Harry Madison Sr.

John Farrell was the last to be buried in this cemetery. (A part of the cemetery was reserved for negroes.)
